5. *A VASE is a receptacle, the height of which is greater than the diameter.*
6. *A BOWL is a receptacle, the diameter of the mouth which is greater than the height.*
7. *OWN FOLIAGE is that of said flower.*
8. *Wherever the schedule calls for a certain number of blooms or stems, please exhibit exactly that number. For instance, marigolds, 3 blooms; they must have just 3 blooms, no buds.*
9. **NO EXHIBIT TO BE REMOVED BEFORE 6:00 PM MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 6th, 2021. Any exhibit not claimed by 6:30 pm, Monday, September 2nd 2019, will become the property of the Agricultural Society and will be sold at the Auction, Monday evening.**
10. *Containers will be provided unless otherwise stated, but none will be provided in the Arrangement Section.*
11. **MAKE SURE TO SECURE ALL ENTRY TAGS TO EXHIBITS.**
