Entry Fees: \$4.00 per animal—3 day entries

Entry forms with correct fees must be in the hands of the convenor by entry close date



1. All animals must be stabled before 8 am Saturday and remain on site until close of Fair on Monday.*
 2. **All entries must be well groomed, and in good health and presented for the appreciation of our visitors.**
 3. Display and demonstrations – All animals are expected to participate in at least 1 program each day of the Fair. It is the owner's responsibility to provide an adequate number of handlers for their donkeys. Donkeys in tack may also be seen on display.
 4. All events are intended to entertain and educate our visitors and will be accompanied by a ring commentary. All animals are expected to have adequate training for owner chosen participation. No chains, crops or whips allowed.
 5. Each stall must carry information relating to the animal(s) and accurately describe details of the animal i.e. sex, age
- Clear, clean, easily read signs are essential.** No "For Sale" advertising or phone numbers allowed.
6. Cash remuneration: \$100 for each of the first 2 entries, plus \$75 for any additional entries.*
 7. Stable space is limited and will be allotted at the discretion of the Department convenor. **Early entry of your animals in this Department will allow for stable set up and must be in the hands of the convenor before the entry close date.** Entry fees should be made payable to: N&S Saanich Agricultural Society.
- * Must participate in #1 thru #4 to qualify for this.
