- 4. All entries must be owned and registered in the name of the exhibitor. All entries, except wool breeds, must be shown in short fleece with a neat and tidy appearance. Stall space will limit entries.
- 5. The Sheep Committee reserves the right to order removal of any animal that, in their opinion, and on the advice of a qualified veterinarian, shows evidence of contagious disease or infestation (such as keds).

- 4-002 Yearling Ewe, "Two Tooth" (two Central permanent incisors)—Other three pairs of temporary incisors ("milk teeth") must be firmly in place.
- 4-003 Mature Ewe, born and bred in Canada.
- 4-004 Ram Lamb, "Full Mouth Milk Teeth" (all eight temporary incisors). Born the property of the exhibitor.
- 4-005 Yearling Ram, "Two Tooth" (Two central permanent incisors). Other three pairs of temporary incisors ("milk teeth") must be firmly in place.
- 4-006 Get of Sire (Born the property of the exhibitor). A group of three animals, full mouth milk teeth, by the same sire. Both sexes may be represented. Each animal in the group must have been exhibited in one of the preceding classes. All animals in a group to be of one breed.
- 4-007 Breeders Flock (Bred and owned by the exhibitor). A group of four animals. Both sexes to be represented. Each animal in the group must have been exhibited in one of the preceding classes. All animals in a group to be of one breed.

CLASSES

- 1. Fine Wool white and coloured in the same class
- 2. Long Wool white and coloured in the same class
- 3. Primitive white and coloured in the same class
- 4. Down white and coloured in the same class
- 1. All fleeces entered must be from sheep owned by the person entering the fleece.
- 2. The Fleece Show Convenor and Judge reserve the right to disqualify fleeces which are not up to standard, eg improper skirting, manure tags, matting, excess foreign matter, string, baler twine, cut tips, excessive second cuts, moisture, odor, mildew, mothballs or keds.
- 3. Skirting **before** dropping off the fleece, it is the responsibility of the producer to properly skirt (ALL face, belly, leg and tag wool removed), roll and displayed in a clear plastic bag. Fleece must be in its "natural" condition (no cutting tips, washing or dyeing).
- 4. Fleece must be from sheep shorn since the last Saanich Fair.
- 5. Fleece must be dropped off between 6pm Friday, August 30, 2019 and 9am Sunday September 1st. 2019.
- 6. Fleeces can be removed as of 6pm Monday, September 2nd, 2019
