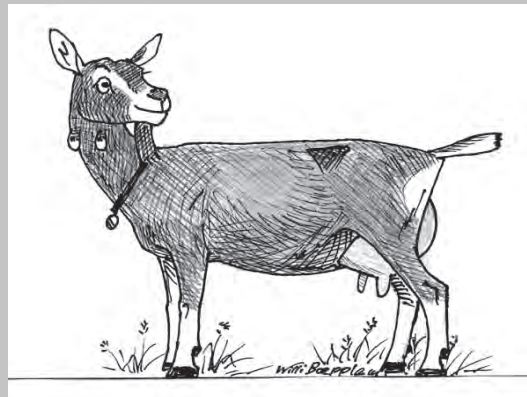
Entry Fee: \$5.00 per animal per class; Group classes, \$5.00 per entry

Date Exhibits To Be Brought In: By 8:30 pm on Friday, September 3rd, 2021



1. Original C.G.S. papers of each animal to be shown must be present on site if they are to compete.
2. No entries accepted over the telephone.
3. All animals must be penned by 8:00 pm on Friday, September 3rd, 2021
4. All animals will require examination by a veterinarian currently licensed to practice in Canada, otherwise they cannot be shown. Goats showing evidence of contagious or infectious disease must be removed from the grounds. The veterinarian's decision is final.
5. Goats with lumps or with lochia (bloody discharge) will not be permitted to show.
6. VET CHECK between 7:00-9:00 pm on September 3rd directly after unloading animals. PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE BARN until your goats and your papers have been checked! Thank you to Dr. Phil Stacey of Saanichton Village Veterinary Hospital for kindly providing the vet check.
7. No Judging
8. All goats must be owned and registered in the name of the Exhibitor. All does' registration numbers must be on entry forms.
9. Permanent Champions may not show in their age class, but MUST show in the Challenge class. They may show in udder and group classes.
10. "Age" is the animal's age on the day of the show, September 1st, 2021.
11. All registration papers and tattoos will be inspected on Friday, September 3rd, 2021 in the evening.
PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE UNTIL YOURS ARE CHECKED!
12. All entries in group classes must be entered in their age classes.
13. Each Breed Section must have at least two Exhibitors.
14. All entries must remain in their pens until 6:00 pm, Monday, September 6th, 2021.
15. C.G.S. rules will govern.
16. No horns, no bucks, no animals not being shown except underage kids on milk (with permission).
17. PRIZE MONEY WON IN LIVESTOCK SECTIONS WILL BE AWARDED BY MAIL WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER FAIR CLOSING.
18. All stalls must be cleaned before leaving the Fairground or forfeit prize money!
19. Stall declarations are mandatory, or else forfeit prize money.
20. Exhibitors from out of town needing Early Release passes MUST request them ON THE ENTRY FORM.
Note: Exhibitors wishing to arrive early MUST clear this with convenor.

OPEN DOE SHOW

1. Doe Kid 3 months to 12 months old
2. Dry Yearlings 12 months to 24 months old, never freshened
3. Doe yearling over 12 months to 24 months, in milk
4. Doe over 24 months and under 36 months, in milk
5. Doe over 36 months in milk

GRAND CHAMPION (Each breed): ROSETTE

CHAMPION CHALLENGE Sponsored by INTEGRITY FEEDS

6. Best Udder of Breed-\$7.50 per entry.
7. Dairy Herd—a group of 4 Does (owned by the exhibitor), of same breed and at least 3 in milk.
8. Get of Sire—three Does by the same sire (not necessarily owned by one exhibitor). Name sire on entry form.

9. Produce of Dam—two Does out of the same Dam, name the Dam please.

BEST DOE IN SHOW (Sanctioned)

BEST UDDER IN SHOW (Rosette)

There will be a break for lunch as close to noon as possible, between breeds.

INTERBREED GROUP CLASSES

10. Breeder's Herd—4 Does any age, all of same breed, bred and owned by exhibitor.
