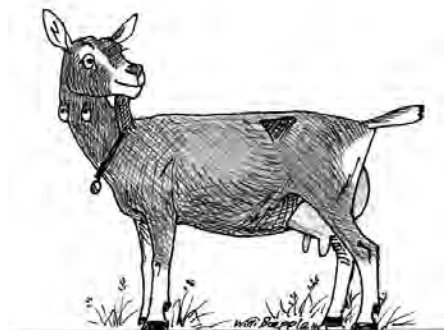

6th-\$25.00; 7th-\$20.00; 8th-\$15.00; 9th-\$10.00; 10th-\$5.00 (to a maximum of two prizes per exhibitor per class)

Date Exhibits To Be Brought In: By 7:00 pm on Friday, September 2nd, 2022

1. This is a Canadian Goat Society (CGS) Sanctioned Goat Show therefore only animals registered in Canada and appearing in the CGS herd book may be exhibited. Full Canadians will be shown in purebred classes.
2. Original CGS registration papers for each animal being shown must be present onsite during competition except for Classes 1 & 2, in which case proof of registration must be available online at the Canadian Livestock Records Corporation (CLRC) web site..
3. No entries accepted over the telephone.
4. All animals must be penned by 7:00 pm on Friday, September 2nd, 2022.
5. All animals will require examination by a veterinarian currently licensed to practice in Canada, otherwise they cannot be shown. Goats showing evidence of contagious or infectious disease must be removed from the grounds. The veterinarian's decision is final. Vet check between 7-9 pm Friday, September 2nd, 2022.
6. Goats with lumps or with lochia (bloody discharge) will not be permitted to show.
7. Open judging commences at 9:00 am on Sunday, September 4th 2022.
8. All goats must be owned and registered in the name of the Exhibitor. All does' registration numbers must be on entry forms.
9. Permanent Champions may not show in their age class, but **MUST** show in the Challenge class. They may show in udder and group classes.
10. "Age" is the animal's age on the day of the show, September 3rd, 2022. A maximum of 14 animals per breed per exhibitor are permitted.
11. All registration papers and tattoos will be inspected on Friday, September 2nd, 2022 in the evening.
PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE UNTIL YOURS ARE CHECKED!
12. All entries in group classes must be entered in their age classes.
13. Limited to two entries per exhibitor per class.
14. All entries must remain in their pens until 6:00 pm, Monday, September 5th, 2022.
15. C.G.S. rules will govern.
16. No horns, no bucks, no animals not being shown except underage kids on milk (with permission).
17. **PRIZE MONEY WON IN LIVESTOCK SECTIONS WILL BE AWARDED BY MAIL WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER FAIR CLOSING.**
18. **All stalls must be cleaned before leaving the Fairground or forfeit prize money!**
19. Stall decorations are mandatory, or else forfeit prize money.
20. No alteration to entries nor substitutions will be accepted after 5:00 pm, Friday, August 19, 2022
21. No entries will be accepted by telephone. No facsimiles please. Original Excel spreadsheets are preferred (send printed copy with payment to Fair office and email original to the convenor (onthe49th@gmail.com). Copies of blank excel entry forms are available from the convenor (onthe49th@gmail.com).

N.B. Exhibitors from out of town needing Early Release passes MUST request them ON THE ENTRY FORM.

Note: Exhibitors wishing to arrive early MUST clear this with convenor.

CLASSES

OPEN DOE SHOW

1. Doe Kid 0 to 3 months old
2. Doe Kid 3 months to 12 months old
3. Dry Yearling 12 months to 24 months old, never freshened
4. Doe yearling over 12 months to 24 months, in milk
5. Doe over 24 months and under 36 months, in milk
6. Doe over 36 months and under 60 months

7. Doe in milk, over 60 months ("aged doe")
8. Best Udder of Breed.
9. Dairy Herd—a group of 4 Does (owned by the exhibitor), of same breed and at least 3 in milk.
10. Get of Sire—three Does by the same sire (not necessarily owned by one exhibitor). **Name sire on entry form.**
11. Produce of Dam—two Does out of the same Dam, name the Dam please.

GRAND CHAMPION (Each breed): ROSETTE CHAMPION CHALLENGE Sponsored by INTEGRITY FEEDS
BEST DOE IN SHOW (Sanctioned)
BEST UDDER IN SHOW (Rosette)
