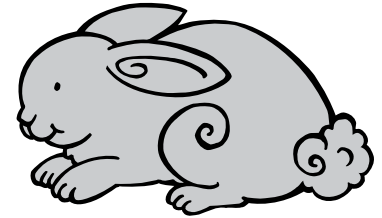

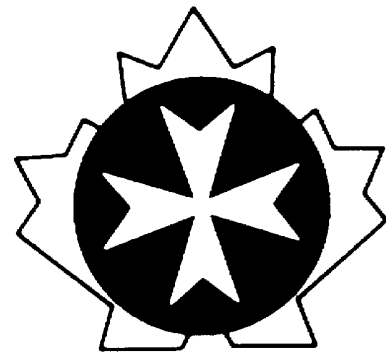

2022 ARBA CONVENTION: OCTOBER 29 - NOVEMBER 2, RENO, NEVADA

- PLEASE USE RABBIT SECTION ENTRY FORMS.**
- Entries must be received no later than 8:00 pm, Wednesday, August 24th accompanied by entry fees. Phone and email **entries accepted until Friday August 26th, 9 pm.**
- Coops will be supplied for breed display, open entries staying in 3 days, pets, doe & litter. **Limited** cooping in per breeder. This is also 2 one-day carrying cage shows. Cages must have leak-proof bottoms.
- NO SALE** of rabbits or cavies Saturday or Sunday. A \$1 fee for each rabbit or cavy sold will be collected and given to the Fair. All "For Sale" rabbits or cavies must be approved by show committee. Coops or table space to be pre-requested on entry forms. Sales open to Department 7 exhibitor and/or members in good standing of a recognized Rabbit or Cavy Club. Rabbits or cavies sold must remain until 6:00, Monday, September 5th if cooped.
- Exhibits must be plainly tattooed in the left ear.** (Pet Class will be excused). There will be a \$2.00 fee if tattooed by the Fair Committee. **Please present animal to committee prior to start of judging for tattooing.**
- Exhibits must be bona fide property of exhibitor for at least 30 days prior to show. All fur, breed fur, and wool entries must be entered in the breed class and may be duplicated in fur or wool classes.
- ALL RABBITS MUST BE IN THE SHOW ROOM** by 9:00 pm, Friday, September 2nd. The Committee will be on hand to receive rabbits from 6 to 9 pm. Out of town by 8:00 am, Saturday, September 3rd.
- Judging commences on Saturday, and no animal may be removed from the pens, other than for judging, until judging is completed. **Carriers are not provided; arrange for carriers if you will not be present.**
- A licensed judge will be in attendance. **Judging 9:00 am, Saturday and Sunday. PRIZE MONEY WON IN LIVESTOCK DEPARTMENTS WILL BE AWARDED BY MAIL WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FAIR CLOSING.**
- No rabbits to leave the showroom until 6:00 pm, Saturday or Sunday. All cooped Rabbits or Cavies, Youth and Pet Rabbits; also Doe and Litter, and Sow and litter (**must remain until 6:00 pm, Monday, September 5th and prize money will be forfeited if this rule is violated**).
- Cooped Rabbits and cavies to be removed Monday between 6 and 6:30 pm.** Committee not responsible for exhibits after this time.
- Doe and litter consists of doe with not less than 4 young, between 6 and 8 weeks old. Meat pens consist of 3 animals not over 69 days old and weight not over 5 1/2 lbs. (Single entries may be duplicated into pre-junior class). Sow and litter 2 or more between 3 and 5 weeks.
- ALL ENTRIES MUST BE PAID FOR WHETHER SHOWN OR NOT.**
- 4H Rabbits in open must remain in rabbit barn.**
- Ear changes **FREE** until Wednesday 6:00 pm. A fee of \$2 will apply after this time.
