1. All classes will be judged according to the General Performance Rules.
2. Exhibitors must follow all rules of the Saanich Fall Fair Horse Show and the Saanich Fall Fair.
3. Entries received after the Closing Date accepted at the discretion of the show committee.
4. The Saanich Fair reserves the right to refuse entry to any party or parties.
5. Exhibitors must produce proof of Horse Council membership.
6. Proper hats and riding boots must be worn by all riders at all times while riding on the show grounds and in the warm up ring. All equipment must be in proper working order.
7. No training equipment will be allowed in the show arena.
8. At this show, all horses in all Western classes may be shown in a snaffle bit.
9. Riders showing in a Western Bit with Shanks must only use 1 Hand on the reins, except in Suitable to be a Western Dressage Horse.
10. Numbers may be displayed on exhibitor's back or on the saddle pad. If displayed on the saddle pad, it must be on both sides. (Extra number provided by exhibitor).
11. No one is allowed to approach or ask questions of the judge during the show unless authorized by the show committee
12. Juniors are prohibited from handling or riding a stallion in any class unless authorized by the show committee at least 3 days prior to the show.
13. Vehicles and/or trailers are **Not** allowed to enter or exit the grounds between 9:00 am & 6:00 pm - No EXCEPTIONS!
14. No horses may arrive before noon on Friday.
15. Vehicles in unauthorized locations will be towed.
16. Exhibitors and their Coaches/Trainers must read and agree to adhere to the VIAHA CODE OF CONDUCT.
- 17. NRTCIP means Not Ready to Canter in Public**
- 18. NO cross entry between NRTCIP classes and Canter Classes**
19. NRTCIP may cross enter into other Walk-Trot classes
20. Trail Horse/Handy Horse is a single class with 2 go arounds (one Saturday and one Monday) only enter as a single class.
21. No entry fee for the Lead Line or Novelty Class.
- 22. NO Early Leaving on Monday. All horse must stay until 6:00pm. Only exception are horses from up Island or off Island. Permission must be obtained from Fair Office.**

- ❖ Exhibitor's age is as of January 1, 2022
- ❖ Classes may not run in strict numerical order.
- ❖ Classes will not begin before the times listed in this prize list. Lunch Breaks will be announced approximately 1 hour before the break.
- ❖ **Prize Money: Open Trail/Handy Horse: 1st Place: \$250, 2nd Place:\$150; 3rd Place: \$100**
- ❖ **Senior Trail/Handy Horse: 1st Place \$100; 2nd Place: \$75; 3rd Place:\$50**
- ❖ **Junior Trail/Handy Horse: 1st Place \$100; 2nd Place: \$75; 3rd Place:\$50**
- ❖ **CHAMPIONSHIP Classes: 1st Place \$25; 2nd Place: \$15; 3rd Place:\$10**
- ❖ Gate calls are a courtesy only. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be on time for their classes.
- ❖ The Walk-Trot/Jog classes on the Saturday schedule do not qualify for any Championship classes on the following days.
- ❖ The 4 Open classes on the Saturday schedule do qualify for their respective Championship classes on the following days.
- ❖ Stalls are on a first-come/first-served basis to those entered in the show. Tack stalls are only available after all horses are stabled.
- ❖ A golf cart is usually available to transport feed and tack if you are parked outside the fenced area.
- ❖ All vehicles must be removed from inside the show grounds by 9:00 am each day
- ❖ **Permits are required for RV's staying on the grounds (Inside the gates) Exhibitors will be assigned to a specific spot and MUST park in assigned spot. A limited number of permits will be issued by the show chairman ONLY to EXHIBITORS attending livestock overnight. No ALCOHOL allowed!**
- ❖ Camping outside the gates in the field does not require a RV Permit
- ❖ **No Dogs** ARE permitted!
- ❖ All exhibitors should be aware the Vancouver Island Arabian Horses Association (VIAHA) will post pictures of exhibitors, owners, handlers and their horses on the VIAHA website and/or Facebook page at their discretion. If you do not wish your photo to be published, please notify VIAHA in writing.
