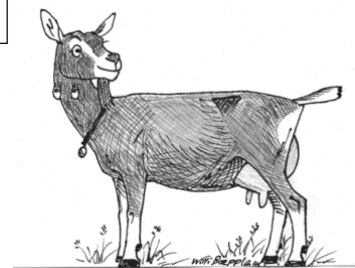

Please note: Prize money will be paid to a maximum of two prizes per exhibitor per class.

SHOW RULES (Fair general rules also apply and take precedence over show rules)

Documentation & Entries

1. This is a Canadian Goat Society (CGS) Sanctioned Goat Show therefore only animals registered in Canada and appearing in the CGS herd book may be exhibited. Full Canadians will be shown in purebred classes.
2. Original CGS registration papers for each animal being shown must be present onsite during competition except for Classes 1 & 2, in which case proof of registration must be available online at the Canadian Livestock Records Corporation (CLRC) web site.
3. Entries must be made online through "AssistExpo" which is accessible on the Saanich Fair website. No entries will be accepted by telephone, mail, or facsimile.
4. All animals must be owned and registered in the name of the Exhibitor. All animals' registration numbers must be clearly listed on entry form.
5. A maximum of 14 animals per breed per exhibitor are permitted.
6. No horned goats and no bucks are permitted at the Fair.
7. No animals not being shown are permitted at the Fair.
8. Prize money will be sent to exhibitors by mail within 30 days of Fair closing.
9. No alteration to entries nor substitutions will be accepted after entry closing date.

Arrival

10. Exhibitors wishing to arrive before 9:00 am on Friday August 31st, 2024 MUST be approved by the Convenor in advance.
11. All animals must be penned by 7:00 pm on Friday, August 31st, 2024.
12. **Exhibitors are expected to decorate their stalls and to provide educational information to fair patrons during the opening hours of the fair (Aug 31-Sep 2).** If stalls are not decorated prize money will be forfeited.

Veterinary & Documentation Check

13. All animals will require a veterinarian examination on site by a veterinarian currently licensed to practice in Canada, otherwise they cannot be shown.
14. The veterinary check will be conducted between 7:00-9:00 pm on Friday, August 31st, 2024.
15. Goats showing evidence of contagious or infectious disease must be removed from the grounds.

CLASSES

OPEN SHOW DOE CLASSES by breed

- 1. Doe, Kid 0-12 months
- 2. Doe, Yearling over 12 months and under 24 months old, never freshened (dry)

< selection of junior champion from classes 1 & 2 >

- 3. Doe in milk, yearling 12 months to 24 months
- 4. Doe in milk, 2 year-old (over 24 months and under 36 months)
- 5. Doe in milk, 3-5 year-old (over 36 months and under 60 months)
- 6. Doe in milk, 5-6 year-old (over 60 months, and under 84 months)
- 7. Doe in milk, 7-year-old and over (over 84 months)

< selection of senior champion from classes 3-7 >

< selection of grand champion from classes 1-8 >

- 8. Champion challenge class

selection of Best of Breed from Grand and Permanent Champions

OPEN SHOW GROUP CLASSES by breed

- 9. Get of Sire - three Does by the same sire (not necessarily owned by one exhibitor). Sire must be named
- 10. Produce of Dam - two Does out of the same dam. Dam must be named
- 11. Dam and daughter (1 dam and 1 daughter). Dam must be named
- 12. Breeder's Herd ("Best 3") - 3 Does any age, all of same breed, bred and owned by the exhibitor.
- 13. Dairy Herd - a group of 4 Does of same breed (owned by the exhibitor)
- 14. Generations class (at least 3 consecutive generations) (not necessarily owned by one exhibitor)

SHOWMANSHIP (YOUTH)

- 15. Senior Showman (ages 17-20 as of June 1st)
- 16. Intermediate 1 Showman (ages 11-13 as of June 1st)
- 17. Intermediate 2 Showman (ages 14-16 as of June 1st)
- 18. Junior Showman (ages 10 years and under as of June 1st)

SPECIAL AWARDS

- GRAND CHAMPION & RESERVE GRAND CHAMPION per breed (rosette)
- CHAMPION CHALLENGE (trophy)
- BEST DOE IN SHOW (rosette & trophy)
