- Judging by: Vancouver Island Horticulture Judges Group. Judging to begin at 8:00 am Saturday, August 31st, 2024.
- Entry tags to be picked up from the convenor of Department 14 on Friday, August 30th, 2024 prior to staging of exhibits.
- More than one entry may be made in any class but must be different varieties or colours. Exhibits must have been grown by or the work of the exhibitor. Exhibitors must arrange their flowers and arrangements in top show condition.
- Name your flowers and plants, as this informs the public and gives everyone more pleasure.**
- A VASE is a receptacle, the height of which is greater than the diameter.
- A BOWL is a receptacle, the diameter of the mouth which is greater than the height.
- OWN FOLIAGE is that of said flower.
- Wherever the schedule calls for a certain number of blooms or stems, please exhibit exactly that number. For instance, marigolds, 3 blooms; they must have just 3 blooms, no buds. Where the schedule calls for 3 stems, enter the flower as it is grown, including blooms and buds.
- NO EXHIBIT TO BE REMOVED BEFORE 6:00 PM MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 2nd, 2024.** Any exhibit not claimed by 6:30 pm, Monday, September 2nd, 2024, will become the property of the Agricultural Society and will be sold at the Auction, Monday evening.
- Containers will be provided unless otherwise stated, but none will be provided in the Arrangement Section.
- MAKE SURE TO SECURE ALL ENTRY TAGS TO EXHIBITS.**
