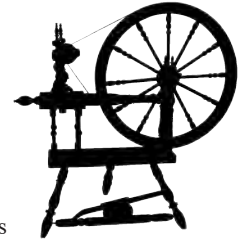

3. With the exception of Section 11-A-009, all items are to be handmade, not mass produced.
4. Each entry must include a legible description of the item, including information about when, where and how it was made and by whom if known.
5. All entries will be handled and displayed with care. Exhibitors may assist the convenor in setting up their exhibits. **However, the Fair cannot accept responsibility for loss or damage.**
6. Entries will be judged based on rarity, condition, age, original workmanship, presentation and appeal.
