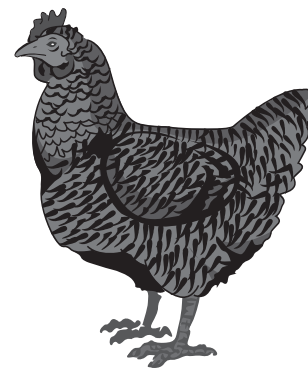

POULTRY SECTION RULES:

1. ENTRIES must be completed online through Assist Expo, Website link is at top of page
2. Please clearly state DIVISION, VARIETY, BREED, COLOUR, and SEX on the entry forms. One bird per line. Please make sure your contact information is correct and easily read in case there are questions.
3. No exhibits are to be removed before 6:00 pm, Monday.
4. Judging commences 8:00 am Saturday, for OPEN CLASS.
5. 4-H will be judged Danish style at 6:30 pm on Friday.
6. 4-H members are responsible for caging their birds and maintaining feed and water containers by 6pm.
7. All entries are judged by the American Standard of Perfection (A.P.A.). CLOSED JUDGING.
8. All advertising including "FOR SALE" signs MUST NOT be in place prior to the completion of judging.
9. Unclean or unhealthy birds WILL NOT be permitted in the show building. THIS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.
10. Prizes will be awarded at the judge's discretion.
11. IF mailing address not complete and correct, prize money will be forfeited.
12. A Junior is 16 years and under.
13. All birds shown must be owned not less than 30 days by the exhibitor.
14. The Fair will not be responsible for loss, injury, death, disease, safety or well-being of exhibitor's entries.
15. Exhibitors of species listed on the Migratory Bird Convention Act must have appropriate permit(s) in place to enter their birds.
16. All eggs collected at the Fair remain the property of the Fair

CHICKENS: All birds entered as COCK (C), COCKEREL (KL), HEN (H), or PULLET (PLT)
PLEASE SPECIFY SINGLE COMB (SC) OR ROSE COMB (RC), BEARDED/NON-BEARDED

WATERFOWL: All birds are entered as OLD DRAKE (ODR), YOUNG DRAKE (YDR), OLD DUCK (OD), YOUNG DUCK (YD), OLD GANDER (OGR), YOUNG GANDER (YGR), OLD GOOSE (OG), YOUNG GOOSE (YG).

TURKEY: All Turkeys are to be entered as OLD TOM (OT), YOUNG TOM (YT), OLD HEN (OH), YOUNG HEN (YH)

UPLAND GAME: All Pheasants are to be entered as COCK (C) or HEN (H); PEACOCK or PEAHEN.
All Quail must be entered as COCK (C), YOUNG COCK (YC), HEN (H), YOUNG HEN (YH)

DOVES: All Doves are to be entered as COCK (C) or HEN (H)

PIGEONS: To be entered as OLD COCK (OC), YOUNG COCK (YC), OLD HEN (OH) OR YOUNG HEN (YH)

DIVISION A: LARGE FOWL

CLASSES:

Eg. American: Plymouth Rock, Rhode Island, New Hampshires, etc.
Asiatic: Brahmas, Cochins, Langshans
English: Cornish, Orpingtons, Sussex, Australorps, etc.
Mediterranean: Leghorns, Minorcas, Anconas, etc.
Continental: Hamburgs, Campines, Polish, etc.
All Other Standard Breeds (AOSB): Sumatras, Aracaunas, Americaunas, etc.

DIVISION B - BANTAMS

CLASSES:

Eg. Game Class: Modern Game, Old English Game
Single Comb Clean Legged (SCCL): Japanese,
Leghorns, Orpingtons, Plymouth Rocks, Rhode Island Red
Rose Comb Clean Legged (RCCL): Hamburgs, Leghorns,
Seabrights, Wyandottes
All Other Comb Clean Legged (AOCCL): Cornish, Polish, Sumatras,
etc.
Feather Legged Class: Booted, Brahmas, Cochin, Silkies, etc.

DIVISION C - WATERFOWL

CLASSES: DUCKS

Eg. Bantam: Call, East Indie, Mallard
Light: Runner, Campbell, Magpie
Medium: Cayuga, Crested, Swedish, Buff
Heavy: Pekin, Rouen, Muscovy, Appleyard



CLASSES: GEESE

Eg. Heavy: Toulouse, Embden, African
Medium: Sebastopol, Pilgrim, American Buff, etc.
Light: Chinese, Canadian, Egyptian, etc.

DIVISION F - TURKEYS

CLASSES

(A) PHEASANTS

Ruffed: Lady Amherst, Golden, Yellow Golden, etc.
True: Chinese Ringneck, Mongolian, Northern Green, etc.
Gallo: Blue, Silver, Kalij, Fireback
Long-Tailed: Reeves, Elliot's, Pacific Copper, Ijima Copper, etc.
Eared: Blue, Brown, Tibetan, etc.
Peafowl: Indian Blue, Green
All Other Classes (AOC): Cheer, Impeyan, Tragopan, Koklass, etc.

(B) PARTRIDGE-QUAIL

Exhibitors provide OWN CAGE
Specify breed e.g. Coturnix, Golden Manch, YC.
