- Judging will be done Friday morning.
- Exhibitors allowed one entry in each class. All exhibits in this section must be the work of the exhibitor and prepared within one year of the fair.
- Judging Criteria:
 - Good preserving technique
 - Appearance
 - Taste and texture
- Jams and jellies are to be properly filled and sealed. Standard bottle tops to be used with screw bands on all sealers. Metal jar lids and self-sealing lids must be new. No wax to be used. No coloured jars. No Freezer jams or jellies accepted. Jars will be opened by the judges. No labels on jars except on the bottom. **PLEASE NOTE SIZE OF JARS REQUIRED.**
- Containers in either Imperial or Metric measure may be used. Considered equivalents are 1 quart & 1 litre, 1 pint and 500 mls and 8 oz and 250 mls.
- PLEASE NOTE:** AOV = Any Other Variety. Unlabeled AOV will not be judged. AOV jars must be labelled on the bottom.
- Please Note: All jams and jellies should be as per category description. No flavouring or mixed fruits except when noted.
- Demonstrations - times to be posted during fair.
