4. All entries must have been grown by the exhibitor and be of this year's production.
5. All entries should be prepared fit for show, free of insects and decay. All entries should be table ready.
6. **NOTE:** all displays or collections of vegetables entered for competition **should have neat labels** indicating the varieties of different vegetables, thus increasing educational value. **Bold print must be used on labels.** If heirloom variety please indicate
7. No exhibits to be removed from the Hall before Monday 6:00 pm. Any exhibits not claimed by 6:15 pm will become the property of the Agricultural Society and will be sold at the Auction Monday evening.
8. **ALL VARIETIES MUST BE NAMED IN THE VEGETABLE DEPARTMENT ESPECIALLY AOV OR WILL NOT BE JUDGED.**
9. Judging of Vegetables based on BC Council of Garden Clubs judging standards.
